New Friday and Saturday Class Schedule

Due to several requests and the need to add a class to train for our upcoming tournament in Korea, the Friday and Saturday class schedules are changing.

Friday Classes:

5:00-6:00 - Combined Class
6:10-7:00 - Tournament Training (Competitors, only)
7:00-7:30 - Korean Language Class (Travelers, only)

Saturday Classes:

9:30-10:20am – Children Class – All Ranks
10:30:11:20am – Adult Class
11:40-12:10 – Instructor Class

On Gup Testing days, we will have the Children Class, but no Adult or Instructor Classes.

New Gup Test Schedule

Due to the large number of students testing at the Gup Tests, we have established the following schedule:

9:30-10:20am – Children Class – All Ranks
10:45-11:30 – Gup Test for **all students, who are currently White Belts thru Orange Belts.**
11:45-12:30 – Gup Test for **all students, who are currently Green Belts thru Red Belts.**
No Adult or Instructor Classes on Gup Testing days.

This new schedule will allow younger children to leave early if they want to on Gup Testing days.

All Ranks!!! Every time you plan to test, ask a Black Belt Instructor to pre-test you at least two weeks before the test. Also, be sure you know all the requirements, as outlined in the KMA handbook, before you pre-test.
